### GARBAGE ONLY

(Applicable to co-collection service only)

Only standard size garbage bags, cans or bundles weighing no more than 45 lbs (20 kg) will be collected.

- disposable diapers
- ceramics, dishes, window glass
- light bulbs, ovenware, crystal
- plastic lids, toys and tools
- foam containers and trays
- metal pots
- waxed or coated boxes, milk containers
- meat, fish, grease, bones, dairy products
- other regular household waste

### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Large items (such as mattresses, chairs, refrigerators, freezers)
- Hazardous waste
- Biomedical waste
- Radioactive waste
- Construction and demolition waste
- Explosive waste (ammunition)

• Please bag together

### PLASTIC BAGS

- Please remove cash register tapes
- Stuff into one bag



### BOXBOARD & FINE PAPER

- Please remove all wrap, spouts & liners
- Flatten and place inside another box
- Place fine paper in same box



### CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- Please flatten and bundle 30" x 30" x 8" all cardboard
- Limit one cubic yard per business



### INSIDE YOUR BLUE BOX



### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

- Please rinse
- Place metal lids in blue box



### ALUMINUM & STEEL BEVERAGE & FOOD CONTAINERS

- Please rinse
- Place lids inside cans & pinch to trap the lid side



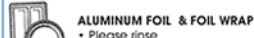
### RIGID SCREW TOP PLASTIC

- Clean screw top plastic containers with symbols marked on the bottom
- Please remove caps



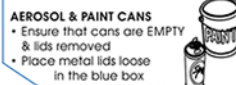
### WIDE MOUTH TUBS

- Clean plastic tubs with symbols



### ALUMINUM FOIL & FOIL WRAP

- Please rinse



### AEROSOL & PAINT CANS

- Ensure that cans are EMPTY & lids removed
- Place metal lids loose in the blue box
