## Blacker Wheelie Upgrade

#### Rural Service Upgraded

Who: Rural residents of the Municipality of Bluewater only currently on a biweekly collection schedule

in the east and west zone with a small wheelie bin.

**What:** You will see your small wheelie bin upgraded to a medium waste bin for the same price.


Why: Council would like to bring some fairness and equality to service provided between urban and

rural residents.

**Where:** Residents of the Municipality of Bluewater only residing in the West rural or East rural zone.

**When:** April 12 and April 19, 2021.

**How:** Follow the instructions on the reverse side to receive the upgrade.





# Blackwater Exchange Process

#### 1 Setout.

On your regular collection day whether it is April 12 (east side) or April 19 (west side) set out your small wheelie bin for collection regardless if it is full or not.

**TIP:** It is very important that we get to empty your bin before an exchange can take place. If you do not wish to have your container changed please contact our office (see below).



#### 2 Leave it.

When your small waste (35W) wheelie bin has been emptied, leave it at the road until we get a chance to take it away and issue your larger medium container.

TIP: A separate vehicle will follow behind with best efforts made to make same day exchanges. Because the process to exchange a container takes longer than emptying the bin, it is possible that your bin will not be upgraded until the next day. Your replacement larger medium container serial number will start with 65W.



### 3 Bring it in.

Once we have delivered your larger wheelie bin you can bring it in where you normally store your wheelie bin in between collection.

**TIP:** The normal biweekly schedule will continue the following week. East zone on April 26 and West zone May 3.
