Using Your Cart is as Easy as 1-2-3!

1. Collect all your materials inside your home

- Gather your recyclable materials using your blue box. Use small kitchen catcher type bags around the house to capture waste wherever it is generated.
- Use a kitchen caddy to accumulate your organics and bluebox to store your recycling.

2. Empty your materials

- Empty contents into designated organics, recycling or waste outdoor bins.
- All organics can be loose, lined with soiled paper or contained withing a BPI Certified compostable bag.
- All food organics can be loose or contained within a BPI certified compostable bag.

3. Set your bins out for collection

- Set out your bins at the road when full (or almost full).
- Residents will only need to set out two carts on any given week. Waste and Recycling are on opposite weeks while organics is weekly. See collection calendar.

Please be aware that your collection day may have changed. Depending on your location, collection will now be scheduled for Mondays, Wednesdays, or Fridays. • Carts must be place at the curb/ 7:00 road by 7 a.m. on your scheduled

- Do not over fill carts, the lids of the carts must fully close.
- All material must be in the carts. Material on the ground or beside the carts will not be collected.
